NON-PROFIT RESIDENCE VISA

This visa allows the holder to reside in Spain for a period of more than 90 days, without the possibility of gainful employment.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

- o National visa application form, duly completed and signed (original and copy).
- o A recent color passport photo on a white background.
- o Passport or travel document recognized as valid in Spain, with a minimum validity of 1 year (original and copy).
- o Form EX-01* duly completed and signed (LO 4/2000 y RD 557/2011)
- o Form Model 790*, code 052, duly completed and signed, valid for payment of the fee established for the application for authorization of temporary or permanent residence, the fee is 440 MRU and must be paid to the Embassy. The applicant must present 3 copies of Form model 790, code 052.
- o Valid public or private health insurance for Spain.
- o Original and copy of the medical certificate proving that the applicant does not suffer from any of the diseases that could have serious repercussions on public health, in accordance with the provisions of the 2005 International Health Regulations. It must be legalized by the Ministry of Justice (Direction des Affaires Civiles et du Sceau), the Mauritanian Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Spanish Embassy.
- o Original and copy of a clean criminal record, issued by the authorities of the country in which the applicant has resided for the last 5 years, in which there should be no convictions for offenses under Spanish law, legalized by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the said country and by the Spanish Embassy. If it is from a country other than Mauritania, it must be legalized by the Spanish embassy in that country.
- o Documents verifying the existence of a regular and sufficient income or the possession of assets guaranteeing said income, with a minimum of 2131.36 euros per month (amount equivalent to 400% of IPREM) and 537.84 euros per additional month (100% of IPREM) for the care, where applicable, of each of the person's dependents, during their stay in Spain. A bank certificate and bank-stamped bank statements for the last six months will be required.
- o Availability of accommodation or proof of means to provide it.
- o If the application is made by a proxy, an original notarized power of attorney and a copy, made no more than one year before the visa application by those exercising parental authority or guardianship.

o Any additional documents deemed necessary may be requested from the applicant. Applicants may also be asked to attend an interview with consular staff.

o The application fee is MRU 9,510, to which may be added the additional costs of the company receiving the applications.

When the application is handed in, a formal examination of the file will be carried out, and the applicant may be asked to appear at a later date. At that point, and based on a more detailed examination of the file, a personal interview or additional documents may be requested.

Failure to appear will result in the applicant being deemed to have withdrawn from further proceedings, except in duly accredited cases of force majeure.

- Pay the fees for forms model 790, code 052 and EX01.
